



## Women's Empowerment's Intern Description

Women's Empowerment (WE) is looking for a master's level intern in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Vocational Rehabilitation or similar program to join our dynamic team!

*The mission of Women's Empowerment is to educate and empower women who are experiencing homelessness with the skills and confidence necessary to get a job, maintain a healthy lifestyle, and regain a home for themselves and their children.*

### Expectations

- Ability to commit to WE for six months to one year for continuity of care and upon completion, will receive a small stipend
- Self-starter, motivated and capable of taking initiative
- Have a strength based and client centered approach (No shame zone philosophy)
- Experience working with diverse and underserved populations
- Have trauma-informed training or experience in delivering trauma-informed services
- Knowledge of current Sacramento resources
- Knowledge of barriers women experiencing homelessness face
- Possess crisis intervention and de-escalation skills
- Excellent communication skills
- Deliver in-person client services (walk-in's/triage, scheduled one on one appointments, class or enrichment facilitation, intake interviews) at least three days a week (20-24 hours minimum on-site)
- Can collaborate with a multi-disciplinary team of Social Workers, Employment Specialist and Housing Specialist to support the best interests of the women WE serve
- Attend weekly Program Team Meetings which typically occur Wednesday's 3:00-4:30
- Meet regularly with Social Workers for client consultations
- Ability to record written progress notes
- Enter progress notes into electronic Apricot Data system in a timely manner
- Provide Master's level school documentation and requirements to WE for programs in counseling, social work, psychology, public health, or women's studies
- Pass Lifescan/background check
- Clinical supervision offered if needed by an outside LMFT or LCSW with knowledge of Women's Empowerment
- Obtain a COVID test and provide documentation of results prior to beginning
